We provide a free home delivery service to Derbyshire residents who are unable to visit a library due to:

- disability
- limited mobility
- illness
- caring responsibilities

When you apply for the Home Library Service, we'll contact you to talk about your needs, and find out what you like to listen to or read. Our home library assistants will then visit you once every 4 weeks in your own home, care home or sheltered housing.



Alternatively, if you have a friend, relative, or carer who could visit the library on your behalf to select and collect items, we can provide a Friends and Family library card. Benefits include:

- Borrowing up to 24 items
- Free requests
- No charges on overdue books
- 8 week loan period
